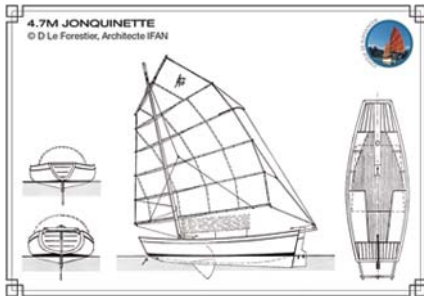


# JONQUE DE PLAISANCE®

## JDP MODELS - THEIR PRINCIPAL CHARACTERISTICS



### 4.72 m JONQUINETTE

Overall length (with davits): 5.5 m  
 Hull length: 4.72 m  
 Draught: 0.35 / 0.70 m  
 Sail area: 13.20 m<sup>2</sup>



### 9 m MINIJONQUE

Overall length (without davits): 9.06 m  
 Hull length: 8.55 m  
 Draught: 0.90 / 1.80 m  
 Sail area: 46.5 m<sup>2</sup>

### 10.5 m JDP

Overall length (without): 10.58 m  
 Hull length: 9.78 m  
 Draught: 1.00 / 2.00 m  
 Sail area: 52 m<sup>2</sup>



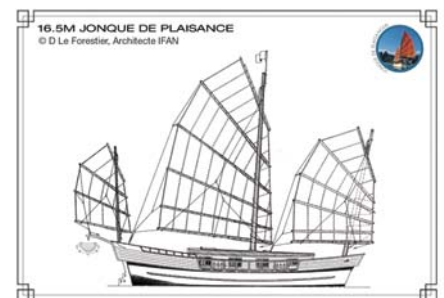
### 12.5 m JDP

Overall length: 12.50 m  
 Hull length: 10.92 m  
 Draught: 1.20 / 2.20 m  
 Sail area: 80 m<sup>2</sup>



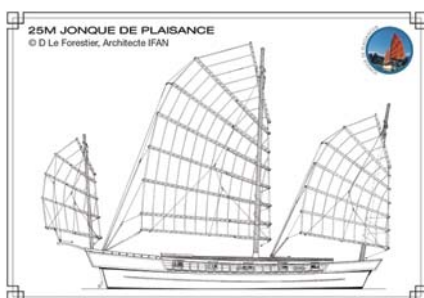
### 14.5 m JDP

Overall length: 14.15 m  
 Hull length: 12.55 m  
 Draught: 1.26 / 2.30 m  
 Sail area: 98 m<sup>2</sup>



### 16.5 m JDP

Overall length (with rear davits): 16.54 m  
 Hull length: 15.62 m  
 Draught: 1.5 / 2.25 m  
 Sail area: 118 m<sup>2</sup>



### 25 m JDP

Overall length: 26.25 m  
 Hull length: 25.17 m  
 Draught: 2.40 m  
 Sail area: 300 m<sup>2</sup>

### Standards pour Circumnavigation

All JDPs 12.5m or more have been designed according to european standards for circumnavigation.

The 12.5m and 14m JDPs have the 1st Category certification (current equivalent: Category A (CE) in France).

The 16.5m JDP has the NUC category: Ship for Commercial Use, Maritime Affairs.
